I was appointed to this position two years ago after completing my term on the Human Rights Committee. I asked what the criterion is for the position and there did not seem to be one for this role.

I have neither been contacted for advice nor invited to a meeting to be kept informed about the work done by the Human Rights Committee during the past two years. Therefore, I have nothing to report.

However, I recommend that this position be reassessed by NEB to draft guidelines and criterions that would clearly outline the responsibilities and processes. I think it is important to seek advice from the community on NAJC human rights issues.
